Music Tuition Scholarships for 2018 Information

Carey Baptist Grammar School is pleased to announce the following Music Tuition Scholarships and bursaries available for 2018. Auditions for these awards will be held in the De Young Centre for the Performing Arts at Carey Baptist Grammar School on **Monday 13 November**.

The following scholarships and bursaries are available:

Mellor Music Tuition Scholarship

This is open to students in Years 6 to 11 at the date of audition. The value is **full** tuition on one instrument/voice for one year. Carey Baptist Grammar School funds the award annually. This may be awarded to an advanced student or to a promising student. This scholarship is named after the Mellor family who has made a continued contribution to Carey over many years.

Junior School Tuition Scholarship

This is open to students who will be enrolled in Junior School next year at Kew or Donvale. The value is **full** tuition on one instrument/voice for one year. Carey Baptist Grammar School funds the award annually. This may be awarded to an advanced student or to a promising student. The minimum standard is AMEB 2nd Grade or equivalent or Suzuki Book 2.

George Dobson Bursary

Open to students at any year level. The value of the bursary is \$500 and the Friends of Carey Music fund the award annually. This bursary may be awarded to an advanced or promising student and is named after a well-loved former instrumental music teacher at Carey.

Robert Rosen Bursary

This is open to students at any year level. The value of the bursary is \$500 and the Friends of Carey Music fund the award annually. This may be awarded to an advanced student or to a promising student. This scholarship is named after the late Robert Rosen, a former music teacher in Junior School and professional orchestral and opera conductor whose choirs were magnificent.

Tom Howley Bursary

This is open to students at any year level. The value of the bursary is \$500 and the Friends of Carey Music fund the award annually. This may be awarded to an advanced student or to a promising student. This scholarship is named after a former instrumental teacher at Carey quite a few years ago who is fondly remembered by many past students.

Jason McNee Bursary

This is open to any piano student in Year 2 or 3 at the date of audition who attends Kew campus. The value is a \$400 **bursary** towards piano tuition fees for one year. The McNee family offers this scholarship in memory of their son, a former Junior School Kew Student. In the audition, the student is expected to demonstrate that they can play with two hands together with chords or broken chords in the left hand.

Conditions:

1. These scholarships and bursaries are awarded to students already enrolled at Carey.
2. Winners of the Mellor or Junior School Tuition Scholarships are expected to learn from Carey Music teachers on the instrument auditioned.
3. A student cannot hold any scholarship or bursary for two consecutive years.
4. Students studying practical music at VCE or IB level are already entitled to get a 25% rebate on tuition fees for VCE & IB (Units 1 & 2) and 50% rebate on tuition fees for Units 3 & 4. They cannot receive both a scholarship and a rebate.
5. The audition will last approximately 10 minutes and will include performance of two short contrasting pieces (or excerpts). Some aural perception tests may be given and questions may be asked about involvement in music making and music studies.
6. **Endorsement from a member of Carey Music staff is required to support the application.**
7. The tenure of the scholarship is conditional upon a student's maintaining a high standard of musicianship, attitude, behavior and musical contribution to the school. Recipients will be expected to contribute actively to the musical life of the school as well as perform at the various recitals scheduled throughout the year.

Most students will need an accompanist which can be provided by the school. Please use the application form attached and **provide all necessary sheet music with this application.**
